

Orchestra Clinic in City Schools Begins Tomorrow

Dale Kempter, instructor of music at Eastern New Mexico University, will be guest conductor and clinician for the annual orchestra clinic that starts

tomorrow in the Hobbs municipal schools, according to David Hooten, orchestra director.

Kempter, a cellist of note, will work with string students from elementary through senior high, tomorrow, Friday and Saturday morning. A grand concert in the high school auditorium at 8 p.m. Saturday evening will climax the three-day clinic. The public is invited to the concert and no admission will be charged.

Kempter has received three degrees — bachelor of music education and bachelor of music, both from the University of Kansas, and a master of music education from the University of New Mexico.

Prior to joining the faculty of the School of Music at ENMU in the fall of 1961, he had been music instructor and director of orchestra in the Albuquerque public schools.

He has played professionally with the Albuquerque Civic Symphony and the New Mexico Chamber Orchestra and is a professional dance-band drummer. He is presently vice-president of the New Mexico Music Educators Association.
