

Constitution of the Albuquerque Youth Symphony
Article I

Name:

Albuquerque Youth Symphony

Article II

Purpose:

To offer an opportunity for junior and senior high school students to take part in the rehearsal, the performance, and the enjoyment of a symphony orchestra and to better themselves on their chosen instruments.

Article III

Qualifications of members:

All members:

- 1) must be members of an Albuquerque high school ^{a junior high school} and be in the band or orchestra program in their respective schools; and, if in junior high school, must have a recommendation from their music teachers in their schools.
- 2) must audition for the musical directors of the Youth Symphony at the beginning of each year.
- 3) must fulfill the requirements of all the directors.

Article IV

Duties of Members:

All members are required to:

- 1) attend each rehearsal on ^{each} Saturday from 9:45 AM. to noon unless otherwise specified by the directors or excused.

A. Excuses may be made for sickness or other serious circumstances and are made by contacting the directors or Vice-President;

- 2) attend all performances given by the Youth Symphony unless excused as above.

Article V

Dismissal of members:

Members may be dismissed if:

- 1) they have two unexcused absences from rehearsal;
- 2) they have missed any performance without a legitimate excuse.

Article VI

Officers - requirements and election:

- 1) The governing body of the Youth Symphony shall consist of President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer; Board of Representatives, Board of Musical Directors, and Board of Directors.
- 2) The ~~Vice~~ President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer shall be members of the youth

Symphony for at least one preceding year
and must be in the 12th grade.

3) Elections of the officers and Board of Representatives
shall be held at the end of each school
year by the members of the Youth Symphony.
