All members of AYSP must be enrolled as regular members of their curricular school band or orchestra, if available, for the duration of their participation in AYSP. This is an important statement of support for school music programs which serve a broad range of students with varying levels of ability. We expect AYSP musicians to participate in and be leaders of those school programs. By participating in school music programs, students benefit from playing every day, become better sight-readers and musicians, and play an important part in helping to build strong music programs in our schools and community. All AYSP participants must have written approval from the **school band or orchestra teacher** of their school band or orchestra program, when such a program exists. In order to uphold this policy, your band or orchestra teacher must sign a statement supporting your placement and involvement with AYSP.
